

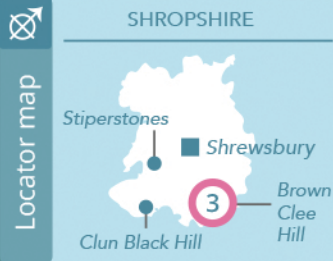


# Brown Clee Hill Circular Walk

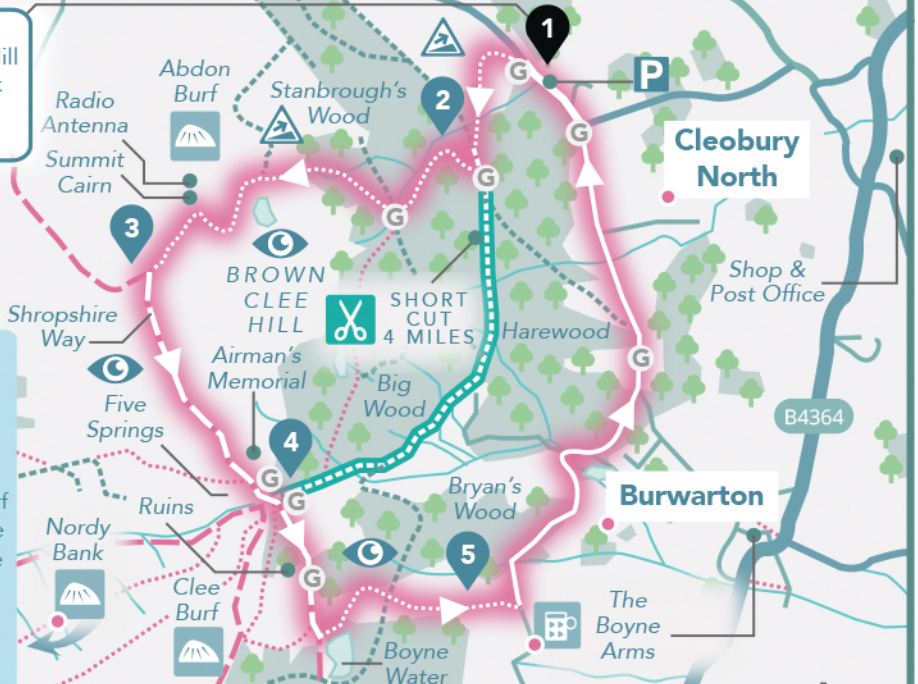

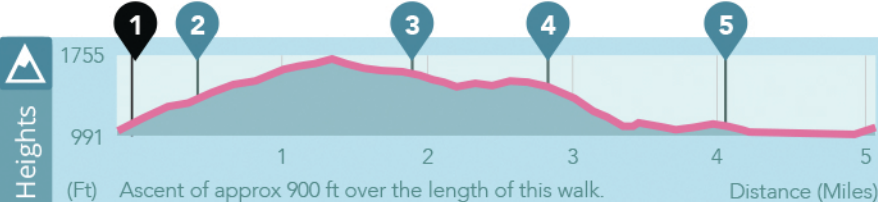
## Brown Clee's Forts

This route has been designed to complement O/S Explorer map No. 217

- Directions**
- Key TL = Turn Left, TR = Turn Right
- 1 Arriving from Cleobury North - park on the right at the roadside parking section at WV16 6TA. Look for the pedestrian gate towards the end of the parking section on the left side of the road. **Please take care on this road.** Go through the gate uphill through the gorse. The path snakes around uphill and eventually joins a forest road. Bear left here and then TR shortly afterwards through a pedestrian gate up through Stanborough's wood.
  - 2 Continue on path as it snakes uphill through Stanborough's wood eventually reaching a gate and track 'T' junction. Continue straight over track through pine trees. Path bears right and heads uphill through heathland until steeper section before it meets Radio Antenna access road. TL here and follow the road uphill over a cattle grid, TL just before
  - 3 antenna to the summit cairn. Then after the cairn continue straight downhill on the path towards the fence below.
  - 3 Bear left and follow the fenceline along and downhill towards Five Springs. Consider looking at the Airmen's memorial off path to the left before you reach a wooden gate near the woods. Continue through the gate and down to wood edge and another gate. Go through gate and then TR through a pedestrian gate.
  - 4 Continue over open field passing ruined buildings on your right to another gate. Go through gate and follow track until you see Boyne Water on your left. TL here on track running just before the lake then TL through gate on onto open heathland. Continue across open heath to far fence, path now bears right downhill to eventual
  - 5 gate. Continue through gate downhill on path through open sheep pastures and old trees until you reach the 'T' junction with tarmaced track at the bottom.
  - 5 TL here on track, follow this over a cattle grid as it snakes around on a contour through Bryan's wood. This track eventually leaves the woods into more open ground at Harewood with sheep pastures on either side of it as it heads to the corner of the road. **Please take care on this road.** Pass through gate onto the right hand side of the road and walk uphill on the side of the cars until you reach your start point and walk's end.
